Les Hall of 336 E. Huron Street addressed the council with concerns of the volume and duration of the outdoor music events allowed at Overdogs.

Esther Faust of 310 Jefferson Avenue addressed the council requesting the extension of their premises amendment time from 9:00 pm to 11:00 pm as it is for her wedding celebration. She indicated that the wedding party was to be open to the public and will be used as fundraising for the local food pantry and the animal shelter.

Tim Doolittle of 232 Adams Avenue spoke in favor of adjusting the time to 11:00 pm.

John Horan addressed the council and stressed their previous cooperation with keeping noise levels down. They plan on erecting a sided tent on the site to buffer the noise for nearby residents.

The council discussed the past history of time allowances for events outdoors in residential neighborhoods. **Jason Reeves motioned and Gordon Garvens seconded to amend the premises amendment for Overdogs Bar & Grill on August 4th 2012 to 11:00 pm.
